 - > NLK has responsible for bibliographic standardization according to the *Library Act*
 - > Roles and functions of the division

Data management bibliographic and authority data about offline resources

Standards management encoding schemes, indexing & display rules, cataloging guidelines for all resources

Identifier management *ISBN, ISSN, ISNI*

- metadata about online and offline resources

- indices for monographs and serials
- by our catalogers and outsourcing

- Korean National bibliography, Korean Authority File
- OCLC batch load & metadata Romanization for Korean materials
- KOLIS-NET*(Cooperative Cataloging Programs) project
 * Korean Library Information-Network

Rules & Standards


- establishment and revision of KS for KORMARC
- schemes and guidelines for KORMARC, MODS and Dublin Core, mapping rules among metadata
- index and display rules for library catalogues
- International Standard Identifiers(ISBN, ISSN, ISNI)

Activities for metadata standards

- Efforts for metadata quality
 - > KORean MARC (KORMARC)
 - Bibliographic, Authority, and Holdings formats listed in the Korean Industrial Standards (KS)
 - Published on a web page for librarians and libraries
 - Reviewed every five years for renewal and revisions are made,
 if necessary

- Efforts for metadata quality
 - > Application and guidelines
 - Cataloging manuals for offline resources, for example monograph, serial, non-book, thesis and western book
 - Guidelines for authority data and NLSH(National Library of Korea Subject Headings)
 - Application guidelines for online resources based on MODS
 (Metadata Object Description Schema)

- Efforts for metadata quality
 - > Crosswalks & mapping rules for various bibliographic metadata.
 - KORMARC MODS
 - KORMARC MARC21 for OCLC's WorldCat batch load

- Metadata promotion in Korea
 - > Regional member of DCMI since 2006
 - Management of DCMI metadata terms interpretation for Korean language
 - In 2021, NLK revised and opened the 2020 version of DCMI terms in Korean on the official web page
 - Application guideline for Open Access Korea system based on DC
 - OAK = Korea National repository and collaboration network

- Metadata promotion in Korea
 - > Data service management
 - Web service of Korean National Bibliography
 - KNB (Korean National Bibliography) Global project via OCLC-WorldCat batch-load since 2016
 - KOLIS-NET (Cooperative cataloging system among Korean libraries)
 - > Education and training for librarian and commercial vendors
 - Introduction to the metadata in the library and information field
 - Metadata management and application for new types of resources

- Indexing and display rules for library catalogues
 - Indexing
 - Main & added entries in tradition (card) catalogue
 - Access points in modern catalogues (metadata)
 - Determining the indexed scope and elements of metadata underlying library search engines
 - Display
 - Specify a brief and detailed display of library search results
 - Similar display representation regardless of metadata type

our Future

- High quality, but low cost
 - > Our works should be improved to be more intelligent and efficient
 - > Excavating and using non-library data in cataloging workflow
 - Journal article metadata and KCI (Korean Citation Index) by
 National Research Foundation in Korea
 - > The more standardization of data format is strengthened, the higher the possibility of automatic conversion and use of external data

our Future

- Rethinking Library Search
 - > The ultimate goal of standardizing library data is for users and machines to explore our resources better
 - > Advanced search algorithms optimized for on our own resources
 - > Taskforce with our staffs and library experts from Aug. 2021
 - Review and correct index rules and ranking criteria
 - If not Google, it is required to pay attention to our unique features of the library search

our Future

- National Bibliography 2030
 - Transforming MARC based framework to Linked Data
 (BIBFRAME) until 2030
 - 1 Application of global bibliographic standard model and rules
 - 2 Development of K-BIBFRAME standard and glossary
 - 3 Network and governance with libraries in Korea
 - 4 Empower our staffs with metadata expertise and skills
